Student Attendance

If your child will be absent or late for any reason, **please make sure to contact the school promptly**. The school email and voicemail are perfectly acceptable — no need to wait for office hours. Bussing

As you may recall, bus procedures changed a bit last year. As a reminder, bus students are automatically approved for transportation from their normal residence, but if you require bus service to or from another location (such as a daycare), that requires annual approval from the Transportation Department. Forms are available at the school office or on the school division website under Bussing Info.
